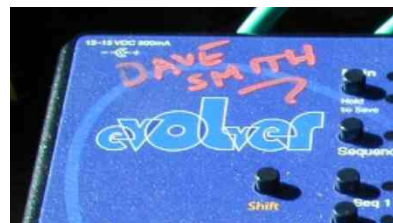

To transmit the sounds to your Evolver you either need the above mentioned editor or a SysEx tool like MidiOx -> <http://www.midiox.com/>

#### WARNING !

Dumping the files to your Evolver will overwrite the internal sounds in Banks C and D !

Please back up \*ALL\* your own data of the Evolver by Midi Dump to your computer  
\*BEFORE\* transmitting this soundsets.

#### Important:

Do not transmit these sounds if your Evolver isn't connected to a midi keyboard. ALL sounds require midi triggering. If you play them without sending a midi note to the Evolver you will only hear very deep noises.

My Evolver is transposed down by 12 semitones, I suggest a similar setting. Don't forget to use mod wheel, pitchbender and aftertouch often ;-)

The sounds were generated during a period of 12 months. Now that I got the time to sort the RAM contents of my Evolver, I wasn't quite sure in every case if a certain sound is my own creation or if it was a factory preset or someone elses sound.

I'd appreciate a notification if you discover a factory preset or a sound programmed by someone else in one of the banks or if you find any doubles.
